



South Fayette PTA's 7th Annual Read-A-Thon

The South Fayette PTA invites all students in kindergarten through fifth grade to take part in the 2023 Read-A-Thon event. This year, there are three different ways that students can participate and everyone that participates will be eligible to win a fun reading experience!

How to participate:

1. Register online for Read-A-Thon and select how your child will participate. A separate form should be completed for each participating student. The choices are:
 - a. **Reading Bingo!** Print out your Bingo card and start completing activities to earn Bingo. You can collect pledges based on the number of squares that you complete on your Bingo card.
 - b. **Reading Log.** Print out the provided reading log and begin tracking your reading minutes. You can collect pledges based on the number of minutes that you read throughout Read-A-Thon.
 - c. **Set a reading goal.** Choose your own reading goal and work towards meeting that goal over the next few weeks. Maybe you are not an avid reader - no problem! Pick a goal that you are comfortable with (maybe it is to read one book per week or one chapter book over the next few weeks) and collect pledges as you work to meet that goal.
2. Parents/guardians should **register for a fundraising account**, establish their child's goals, and share their child's personal link with family and friends.
3. Supports can make a pledge online by:
 - a. Visiting the event website
 - b. Using a child's custom link
 - c. Texting SFRead2023 to (520) 263-0024.
4. Pledges can be made by credit card or by check. Check donations should be sent to the school by **Wednesday, March 29**, in an envelope labeled "Read-a-Thon."

Prizes!

The top five fundraisers from both the Elementary and Intermediate schools will be invited to a special **Lunch with the Librarian** event in the South Fayette Pride Room on Wednesday, April 5!

Every student that participates and raises a minimum of \$20 will be entered into a drawing and five students from each building will be randomly selected to be the "Librarian for a Day" during their library special.
